

Community Dietitian (Part-Time)

Rate starting at \$25/hour

Peoria Grown, a nonprofit providing access to fresh produce and education on nutrition, is looking for a part-time dietitian to develop and lead nutrition education programs and manage program operations. The dietitian will work to prepare and lead classes for various cooking programs. This position will report directly to the Executive Director and require availability on evenings and weekends, up to 15 hours a week. Travel within the Peoria-area is required. Administrative work will be completed remotely.

Essential Duties:

1. Research healthy recipes for cooking classes and provide recipe testing for cooking programs and recipe database.
2. Manage relationships with community partners through coordination and scheduling of cooking programs.
3. Lead classrooms of up to 10 participants in cooking demonstrations including produce preparation and cleaning, cutting, cooking, and serving.
4. Keep attendees on track and safe while utilizing cooking equipment including sharp objects, heat sources, and kitchen sanitation procedures.
5. Build grocery lists for recipe database and/or grocery shop online or in person.
6. Maintain recipe database on Peoria Grown's website
7. Project a professional image to all classes while presenting Peoria Grown.
8. Travel to a variety of locations/kitchens in Peoria to lead cooking programs.
9. Collect and supply information to Peoria Grown regarding attendance, survey data, and feedback from cooking programs.
10. Provide expense reports and feedback in a timely basis.
11. Create and publish nutrition education content to Peoria Grown's social media accounts (Facebook and Instagram).
12. Serve as preceptor to dietetic interns during rotational periods.

Qualifications:

Registered Dietitian or bachelor's degree in dietetics, nutrition, or related field. ServSafe certification required. Requires valid IL driver's license and reliable transportation.
